Homicide Details:	<p>On Monday 19 December 1988, builder David Oliver attended ██████ Newton Street, Alexandria to provide a quote for repairs to the property. The property is described as a single storey detached dwelling that consists of two bedrooms. The living room, kitchen and bathroom are situated at the rear of the property. There is a small hallway on the southern alignment of the property. A side gate and pathway are situated on the northern alignment that leads to the rear of the property. At the rear of the property is a small detached building that is the laundry and a small storage facility, a few chemicals and apparatus were also in this building. The rear yard is cemented, also in the rear yard there is a garden that contains several high foliage plants, including numerous established plants.</p> <p>About 11.00am, Wednesday 28 December 1988, Oliver completed repairs to the deceased's house. Oliver attempted to raise the deceased on several occasions by knocking on the door and ringing his house without a response. Oliver attended one of the deceased neighbour's premises and spoke with Bob Gannon.</p> <p>About 12.15pm, Thursday 29 December 1988 Mr Ronald Sigsworth attended the front of ██████ Newton Street, Alexandria after being summoned by fellow neighbour, Gannon. At this time, Gannon was standing at the front of the premises with Oliver. Oliver informed Sigsworth that he was having trouble contacting the deceased. Sigsworth walked to the rear of the property with Oliver, where he saw that the rear door and flyscreen were open, and the deceased's dogs were in the kitchen. Sigsworth called out to the deceased but received no response, he heard water running and looked in through the open bathroom window where he saw William Allen slumped and kneeling into the bathtub with water running, he was deceased. Sigsworth returned home and contacted police.</p>

Colin FRISK states DUNN and ALLEN were best friends who worked at Marist Brothers, Peshurst. DUNN in Adelaide when ALLEN murdered. DUNN had a number of ALLEN's movies which featured ALLEN/DUNN. ALLEN had a [REDACTED] and would cruise Alexandria Park near the school. [REDACTED] 1428 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] met a [REDACTED] 1356 whom [REDACTED] 1428 feels may have committed the murder due to his heroin addiction and former association with ALLEN.

8. 02/05/1991 I: 2522378

Robert DUNN interviewed re ALLEN murder. Stated he met ALLEN about 1970. ALLEN was at Newington College and DUNN at Marist Bros, Peshurst. ALLEN then joined DUNN at Peshurst. They resided together for a short period. DUNN was aware that ALLEN would frequent toilets in the Newtown area but ceased this practice as he believed it to be too dangerous. ALLEN used to deal in marijuana and amphetamines as well as produce amyl nitrate. ALLEN had a collection of pornographic videos including child pornography.

DUNN stated that he had been supplied males on occasion by ALLEN.

Anonymous male caller stated that [REDACTED] at Marist Bros, Peshurst [REDACTED] ALLEN was known to touch the boys. He had seen him 'massage' the boys whilst their trousers were down. There were photographs of ALLEN/DUNN half naked in the science room.

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	<p>(Palace product IN3407)</p> <p>Precop's history. Information contained within occurrence pad entry stated that ALLEN had 3 prior entries for attempt to procure male person.</p> <p>Intelligence report attached to the Richard JOHNSON investigation. [NP233] (known for drugs) and [NP19] were stopped in Alexandria Park, 10.30pm Friday 20/01/1989. 10.40pm [NP51] (close associate of [NP44] and also known for robbery) and [NP78] (not known for criminal offences) were stopped in the park. All four stated that they played basketball in the school. [NP51] and [NP78] stated that [NP235] (CNI: [REDACTED]), [NP234] (drugs/stealing/traffic) in park earlier with them. Police spoke to male – [NP245] [NP245] about death of ALLEN. He indicated that 4 males sighted earlier in park ([NP19], [NP233] and 2 others) were known to commit assault and robberies upon homosexuals in the park.</p>
