**Brief Description:** Murder of William ALLEN (30) on 28 December, 1988.

William Emanuel ALLEN, aged 50 years, was found deceased on the 29 December 1988, at his home address of Newton Street, Alexandria. ALLEN died of the effects of head injuries sustained on the night of the 28 December 1988, following an assault by unknown males in nearby Alexandria Park.

ALLEN was a retired school teacher who identified himself as a homosexual male. ALLEN was also a suspected paedophile, who was cultivating and dealing a large amount of cannabis prior to his death.

The M.O. bears a resemblance to the murder of Richard JOHNSON in 1990 and both murders occurred at the same location, in similar circumstances. Both ALLEN and JOHNSON identified themselves as homosexual males and frequented public toilets in search of sexual partners.

The offenders from the JOHNSON murder were viewed retrospectively as suspects for ALLEN'S murder however no evidence to implicate any of the eight (8) offenders could be obtained.

It can be seen that numerous parties would have a strong motive for wanting to murder ALLEN ranging from the straight forward economic motive of drug users, dealers and criminal associates who were involved with ALLEN in his cannabis business, to revenge by previous victims of ALLEN'S predatory sexual behaviour and also bias related crimes committed against homosexual males at the Alexandria Park location.

Both ALLEN and JOHNSON identified themselves as homosexual males and frequented public toilets in search of sexual partners. The offenders from the JOHNSON murder were viewed retrospectively as suspects for ALLEN'S murder however no evidence to implicate any of the eight (8) offenders could be obtained. It can be seen that numerous parties would have a strong motive for wanting to murder ALLEN ranging from the straight forward economic motive of drug users, dealers and criminal associates who were involved with ALLEN in his cannabis business, to revenge by previous victims of ALLEN'S predatory sexual behaviour and also bias related crimes committed against homosexual males at the Alexandria Park location. |

ALLEN was a retired school teacher who identified himself as a homosexual male. Close friend of ALLEN and convicted paedophile Robert DUNN provided the following information regarding ALLEN'S sexuality. "I first met William ALLEN in the middle of 1979 when I was still teaching. I met him at a conference and we struck up a relationship. I knew Bill to be a homosexual and I would call at his house about three times a week and assist him with a course that he was doing at Sydney University" (ST- 517). ALLEN was also a suspected paedophile, who was cultivating and dealing a large amount of cannabis prior to his death. Following the initial investigation by Redfern Detectives, there was further investigation conducted into the circumstances surrounding the death of ALLEN. This investigation revealed evidence from witnesses Colin FISK and Robert DUNN, that ALLEN was a supplier of illegal drugs and that he had large sums of money and cannabis on the premises, immediately prior to his murder. ALLEN was also in possession of a large number of video cassettes depicting him and other paedophiles engaging in numerous sex acts with young boys at the time of his death. No offenders were charged in relation to the murder of ALLEN but when describing the attack to witness Harry BERWICK before his death, ALLEN described the offenders as, "ST-513). As there were no direct witnesses to the initial assault of ALLEN there is no evidence of any bias related comments, written statements or gestures made by any person/s before, during or after the assault. ALLEN spoke to a number of witnesses directly following his assault in Alexandria Park and did not mention any significant information in respect to gestures or comments being made by any of the persons who assaulted him.

There were no bias related drawings, markings, symbols or graffiti left at the crime scenes. No symbols were noted at either ALLEN'S home address of Newton Street, Alexandria or the Alexandria Park toilet block where he was believed to have been assaulted. The available crime scene photos and the evidence of Crime Scene Officers Sergeant CAMERON, Constable LITTLER and Constable JONES were reviewed all of which do not identify any bias related evidence left at either crime scene location. No persons have ever been charged with ALLEN'S murder and it is unknown if the offenders have any tattoos or bias related markings on their bodies.

No objects or items that represented the work of an OHG were discovered at either of the crime scene locations. No OHG claimed responsibility for the murder of ALLEN. Numerous suspects in the 1990 murder of Richard JOHNSON were interviewed retrospectively and investigated in relation to the murder of ALLEN however no evidence was identified that implicated any of these persons. There are indications that an OHG was likely to be actively targeting homosexual males for assault and robbery offences, at this location, around this time. The location and M.O. bears a resemblance to the murder of Richard JOHNSON in 1990. JOHNSON was also physically assaulted by a large group of males and suffered horrendous injuries to his head and torso, whilst at Alexandria Park toilets, even more so than ALLEN. At the Coronial Inquest into ALLEN'S death on the 4 July 1989, Coroner Ken WALLER indicated that he thought an OHG was involved in the incident. WALLER summised, "Yes well in this case the deceased was a fifty year old man apparently homosexual, he was shown to have gone to Alexandria Park a place frequented by that sought of person and was set upon there and bashed and beaten by unknown persons who persons who are the said they were. There is no reason to doubt what he said. It's a risk of people as the deceased himself admitted when you're on the beat you take the risk. That people indulge in the sport of chasing and assaulting homosexuals, which is a disgraceful estate of affairs and indeed this is the second case I've had where a person has died as a result of being assaulted in the park. By homosexuals, of course, one can say we shouldn't go to the park, but one can say with perhaps more strength that you shouldn't set about in numbers to assault people to such an extent that you kill them. It's a dreadful sought of business and I wish the people could be caught. It's made even worse by the fact that those violent persons revel and enjoy the situation that the victims don't like to report these crimes to Police because of the indignity that attaches to their roles of cruising homosexuals."

In 1990, a homosexual male named Richard JOHNSON was also bashed to death in Alexandria Park toilets by a group of young males described as an OHG. Eight (8) young male offenders were charged in relation to the murder of JOHNSON and were also retrospectively considered as suspects in the 1988 murder of ALLEN. These suspects were investigated by Detectives but no evidence was obtained that implicated any of these suspects in ALLEN'S murder.  It is unknown if ALLEN had been receiving any harassing telephone calls or mail to his home address. None of the witnesses who were friends of ALLEN. These suspects being observed towards ALLEN. |
