Special Commission of Inquiry into LGBTIQ hate crimes – Production of documents pursuant to Summons No. NSWPF5

We refer to:

- summons No. NSWPF5, issued to the Commissioner of NSW Police (**Commissioner**) on 28 July 2022 (**Summons**);
- your letter of 15 June 2023 requesting additional material searches to be conducted and material produced pursuant to the Summons (**Letter**); and
- our letter of 16 June 2023 requesting an extension to comply with the Summons and noting material was being sought from the Government Records Repository.

A copy of the Summons and Letter are **enclosed**.

Production of Documents

The Commissioner is to produce 290 documents in response to the Summons and Letter. A copy of an index listing the documents being produced is also **enclosed** with this letter.
