



SUSPECTED MURDER

\$10,000 REWARD

At 11.30 p.m. on Tuesday the 22nd June, 1976, the body of Ernest Allan Head, 44 years old, was found at ■/49 Grosvenor Crescent, Summer Hill. A post mortem examination disclosed death was caused by multiple stab wounds.

Notice is hereby given that a reward of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) will be paid by the Government of New South Wales for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the death of Ernest Allan Head. In addition, His Excellency the Governor will be advised to extend a free pardon to any accomplice, not being the person who actually committed the crime, who first gives such information.

This reward will remain in force for a period of twelve months from the date of this notice and its allocation will be at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Police.

The urgent assistance and co-operation of the public is specially sought in this matter. Any information, which will be treated as confidential, may be given at any time of the day or night at any Police Station or by telephoning—
