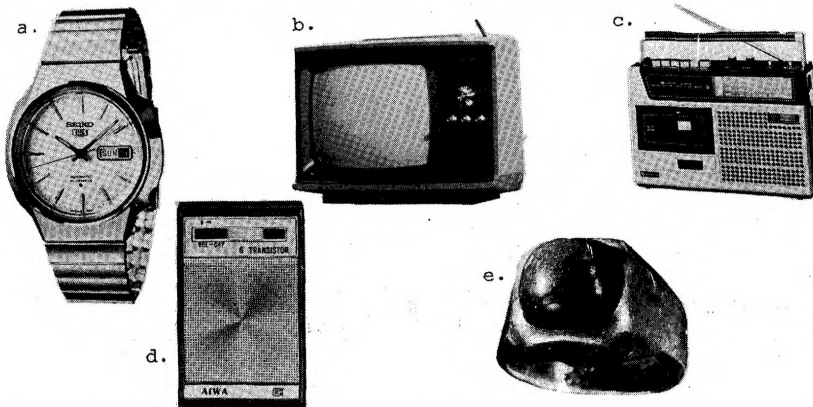
SPECIAL CIRCULAR NO. 76/22

ALLEGED MURDER

AND THEFT OF PROPERTY

1. On the 22nd June, 1976, the body of Ernest Allan HEAD, 44 old, was found in his dwelling house at [redacted]/49 Grosvenor Crescent, Summer Hill. Death was caused by multiple stab wounds and probably occurred during the night on 17th June, 1976. It is suspected that the offender is a homosexual as anal intercourse had been committed upon the victim.

2. The following property is missing from the deceased's home unit and was probably stolen by the offender:-



- a. Gents 'Seiko' calendar wristlet watch, gold, has 3 N6767 and Case No. 6119-7500 engraved on back.
- b. 'Mark Raymond' brand 12" T.V. receiver red colour. Model No. MRT/2, Serial No. 102222.
- c. 'Hitachi' cassette tape recorder, Model No. TRK 1255S.
- d. One 'AIWA' brand transistor 6 Model No. AR 666, in black leather case 4" x 4½" x 1½".
- e. One gold dress ring with green jade type stone, may have 'with love' engraved on inside.
- f. Two pieces of light green jade, roughly cut in triangular shape, 1" long x 3/8 x ½" thick. Approx. value \$500.
- g. One fawny coloured fibre cardboard suitcase with extension hinges. Has "E. A. Head" in black letters stamped on centre outside lid.
