Brief Circumstances of Incident										

Ernest Allan Head was located deceased in his unit at 49 Grosvenor Cr, Summer Hill, about 11.30pm on 22/6/1976. He was naked and had been stabbed 36 times to the chest, body and limbs. Neighbors stated that they heard some argument and screaming from the unit on the evening of 17/6/1976 and the victim had not been seen alive since that time. It appeared that the stabbing commenced in the bedroom of the unit and carried on down the hallway and into the kitchen, where the deceased was located.

Scientific Branch police attended in the early hours of 23/6/1976. A number of exhibits were collected and submitted for analysis. Amongst them were a handkerchief that tested positive to semen and a number of cigarette butts. These items were submitted for analysis (reference <u>FS76/178</u>). Saliva was recovered from the cigarette butts and semen from the handkerchief. The semen from the handkerchief was grouped and the presence of both group O, PGM 2-1 and group B blood group substances (the victim was blood group B) was established. The saliva was also grouped and the presence of group O, PGM 2-1 blood group substances was established. Semen was also present on the anal swab from the deceased, however, there was insufficient for grouping.

The cigarette butts were unfiltered type of the Benson and Hedges brand. They were located filed with the investigation papers. Each is contained in a separate sealed white envelope, labeled FS76/178-29, 31 and 32 respectively, with

details of the contents and where it was located. It would appear that an envelope numbered FS76/178-30 is missing. The envelopes have not been opened since being located.
